IEP = Individual Education Plan

What is an IEP? It is a legal document developed under a U.S. law called IDEA that requires one. An IEP is required for each U.S. public school child who needs special education services and support. An IEP must be reviewed yearly to track the child's educational progress.

PARENTING TIP



Shopping with children can be a difficult task. Here are a few suggestions from the Triple P Parenting Series:

- Prepare ahead. Tell your child where you are going, the purpose of the trip, and what will happen next: "We are going to the grocery store to get food for dinner, then we will go home to make and eat dinner."
- Have just two or three simple rules that you remind beforehand: "Remember to stay with me, use our inside voices and ask before touching any food items." (It is helpful to have rules for what you WANT them to do instead of what NOT to do.)
- Engage your child while shopping. "Can you get that bag of nuggets and put it in the cart?" or "Can you get three apples for us?"
- Think about offering a reward for good behavior.
