A **504 Plan** is a customized roadmap to help students with disabilities thrive in school by providing accommodations, like extra time on tests, to ensure equal access to education. Unlike an IEP (Individualized Education Plan), which offers specialized instruction for students needing academic support, a 504 Plan is for students who do not need special education but still need support. It focuses on removing barriers so kids can fully participate in regular classrooms. ## PARENTING TIP



Every family is different, but what matters most is creating mealtime routines that support your family's needs while helping everyone feel included, safe, and loved.

Mealtimes can be one of the most difficult times for families, but with a little planning, they can become enjoyable for the whole family.

Here are a few tips that might be helpful:

#### Limit snacks and drinks before meals

Try to reduce snacks and drinks close to mealtime to help your child come to the table with an appetite.

#### Give a heads-up

Transitions can be tough. Let your child know when mealtimes are coming up so they have time to shift gears.

#### Model table manners

Children learn best by watching others. Show them what mealtime behavior looks likeuse simple language to describe your actions and invite them to copy you.

#### Set clear, positive rules

A few consistent rules can make mealtimes more predictable. Focus on what to do, like "we use indoor voices" or "we stay at the table," rather than what not to do.

#### Celebrate the wins

A kind word, a high-five, a special treat, or a little extra family time can go a long way.

#### Make it accessible

Adjust the food, seating, and expectations to meet your child's unique needs so they can participate comfortably and confidently.
