

## **Accommodations Vs Modifications**

**Accommodations:** changes **HOW** a student learns, not **What.** *Examples include extended time on tests, large print materials, preferential seating, or text read aloud.* 

**Modifications:** changes **WHAT** a student learns to make it eaiser. Examples include simplified assignments, alternate projects, or reducing the number of test questions.

# PARENTING TIP



Halloween can be magical—but for children with special needs or sensory sensitivities, it can also feel overwhelming. With a bit of planning, you can help make the night safe, fun, and comfortable.

The goal isn't to do everything—it's to create a positive and enjoyable Halloween experience for your child.

- <u>1. Plan Ahead:</u> Read Halloween stories, decorate together, and roleplay trick-or-treating. Use a simple visual schedule with pictures or words to help your child know what to expect.
- <u>2. Keep Costumes Comfortable:</u> Choose soft, tag-free fabrics that don't itch or restrict movement. Try them on beforehand and bring a change of clothes just in case. Adapt costumes for comfort. Remember! Halloween PJs or themed T-shirts are great alternatives.
- 3. Pick the Right Setting: Opt for quieter neighborhoods and sensory-friendly events. You can also go out earlier in the evening to avoid large crowds and noise.
- <u>4. Support their Comfort:</u> Go with familiar friends, bring comfort items, or noise-canceling headphones. Remember to offer choices in activities. Bring your child's communication systems, such as iPad Touch or picture exchange systems.
- <u>5. Include Everyone & Respect Choices:</u> Provide allergy-friendly treats like stickers, small toys, or glow sticks. Listen to your child's feelings and respect their decisions—even if they prefer to skip certain activities or costumes.
